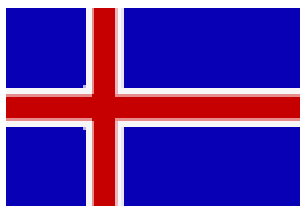


ROVERWAY 2009 - ICELAND



Roverway is an event for young people offered by WOSM and WAGGGS Europe for scouts and guides from the age of 16 to 22 (born 1987-1993). The event is held every 3rd year, each time at a new location. This is your opportunity to head north in 2009 to experience something new, something different within our great movement and make friends from all over the world.

When: 20-28 July 2009

Why: The programme will focus on making new friends, staying together, quite times, diverse cultural activities and having a great time with lots of great people from all over the world.

Prior to the arrival in Iceland participants will be divided into groups of 50. They will get to know each other before arriving to Iceland and prepare for their Journey by communication over the internet.

Roverway will start with an Opening Ceremony on Monday morning the 20th of July 2009 in Reykjavik. Participants will then be transported to different base camps all over the country where they will spend the next four days in the programme they signed up for prior to their arrival in Iceland. We call this part of Roverway

On Friday, 24th of July 2009 everyone will come together at the Ulfjotsvatn Scout Centre for the third part of Roverway, which we call The programme at Althingi will include outdoor activities, workshops, roundtable discussions, challenges, campfires, diverse cultural activities and basically having a great time together.

The Closing Ceremony of Roverway 2009 will be in the evening of 28th of July.

Cost: €449, plus travel to Iceland.

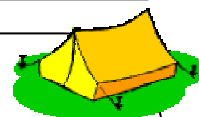
