SITE SERVICES

It all happens on the Camp Site so ensuring all equipment and services are available is critical to the happiness of the campers. Liaison with the Centre and "fixing it" on the site are the prime tasks of this department. We need people who can lead this team?

COMMUNICATIONS

Marketing, publicity, newsletters, web organising, even Camp Radio are some of the responsibilities of this team which contributes to the happiness of the camp. We urgently need these skills added to our team.

INTERNAL SERVICES

Staff support, catering & accommodation, Staff First Aid, Leader Support, Security plus souvenirs and expedition clothing needs a team of dedicated and committed staff. We need to recruit the staff to support all of us.

PROGRAMME, ACTIVITIES & EVENTS

Activities are the highlight of this event and the possibilities are endless. Liaison with KISC and helping units with their planning is crucial to the success of the event, so we are looking for one or two people with proven administration skills and knowledge of both Alpine and on-site activities. The Events Team has now been amalgamated into the programme, so we are also looking for the team that will provide the on-site events, such as the opening and closing ceremony. Are you suitable for this team?

Usually work one day in three, meals supplied and cooked, indoor accommodation, lots of fun and the opportunity to share the "Magic of Kandersteg!"
