“Charlie” sadly passed away on 14th July after a period of declining health. A great supporter of Scouting, wild birds and steam railways.

Having first become a Wolf Cub in the 4th Headstone Group he held many roles at Group, District and County level. Latterly he was a Vice President of Harrow Scout District and will be remembered for the various roles he held in that District, including time as the Lead Volunteer (District Commissioner). In 1999 he received the Silver Wolf and in 2022 the 70 year Service Award.

Many former Venture Scouts will remember him as Assistant County Lead for that section and the many expeditions, including two to Holland, which he led. Others will remember him as part of 4th Harrow, both Senior Scouts and Rover Scouts, Scarbendon and many expeditions.

The funeral, a celebration of his life, took place on Wednesday 14th August and was conducted by Alison Vallance, a leader from 4th Headstone. It was attended by many colleagues and former members of the various sections that he led.
