I had only been speaking to her a matter of a few hours earlier, when she had been telling me of her keep fit classes and the fact that she went swimming regularly each week, and that she was looking forward to Christmas and having her family around.

Pam started her voluntary work in the Guide Movement before becoming a Cub Scout Leader in 1961. Since then she has always been involved with Feltham District. In 1974 she became District Secretary, and more lately Appointment Secretary, positions she held right up until her death. During this time she has supported four District Commissioners.
