It is with sadness that I have to advise you that Shirley Tye has passed away aged 91 years.

She led the 2<sup>nd</sup> Northwood (St Edmunds) Cubs from 1968 to 1985 and then was Assistant District Commissioner for Cub Scouts in Kenton and Kingsbury District for a further eight years. Whilst in K&K she supported the County with Cub Scout Leader training, as one of Grace Hayden's Course Tutors.

Shirley then spent 10 years as Appointments Secretary for Northwood Eastcote District where she and Frank hosted the Appointments Advisory Committee until the District merged with Ruislip in 2007.

She was awarded to Bar to the Award for Merit in 1990.

Her funeral was held at Breakspear Crematorium on Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> March at 1pm. It was conducted by Rev Michael Miller, parish priest at St Edmunds and a participant on one of Shirley's courses.
